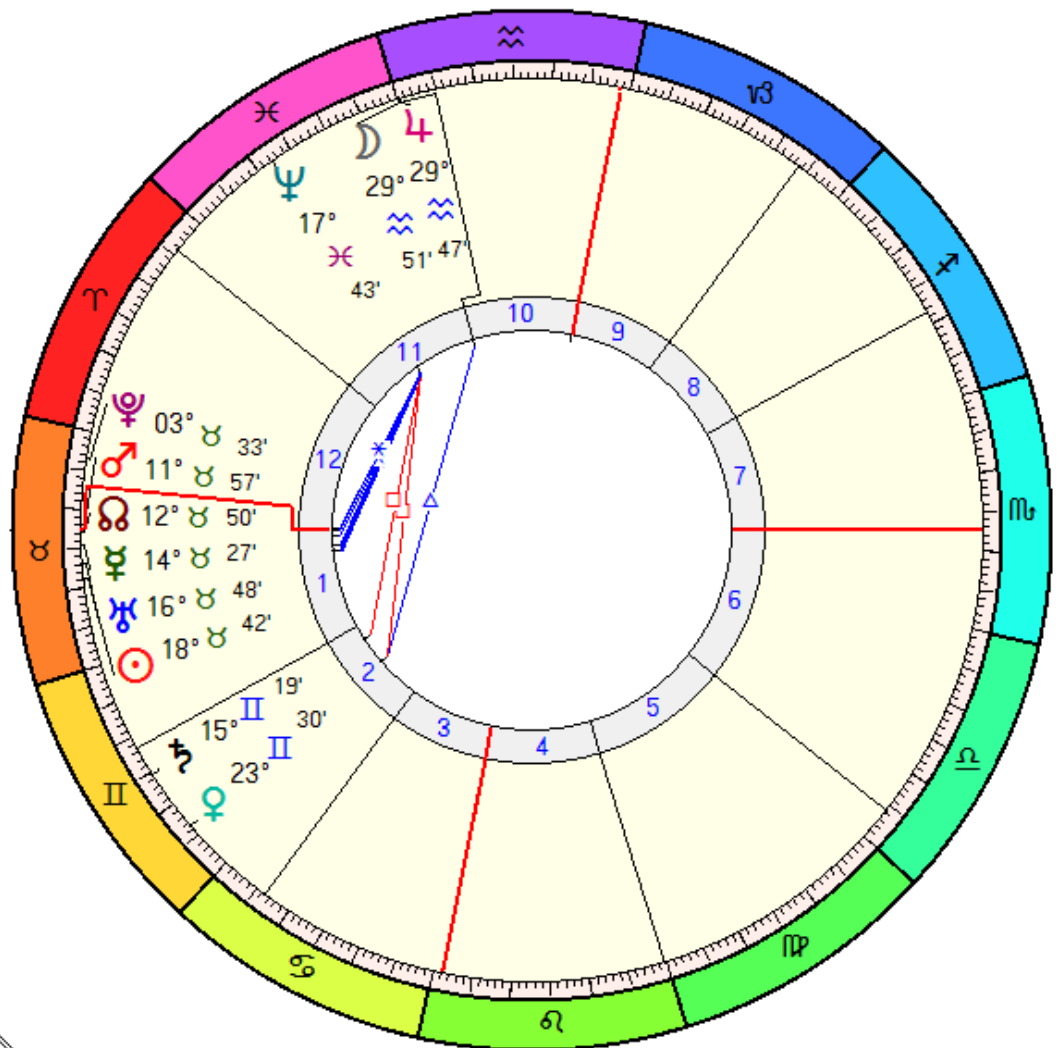

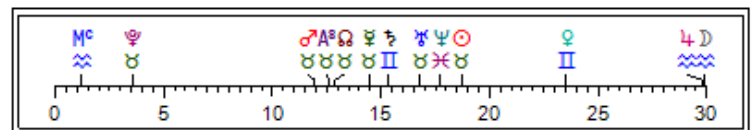

If a planet lies within four degrees of the cusp — the starting line — of the following house, its influence is understood to express itself primarily in the matters of that next house. A planet close to a house boundary will feel very present and active in that area of life; if a description seems less immediate or less relevant, it is usually because the planet is positioned further into the house, towards its middle or end degrees, where its energy operates in a more internal, mature, or subtle way. Please note that for charts calculated without a known birth time, the report will be shorter, as the Rising Sign and exact house placements cannot be determined — only the universal positions of planets in signs and their relationships to one another will be described.

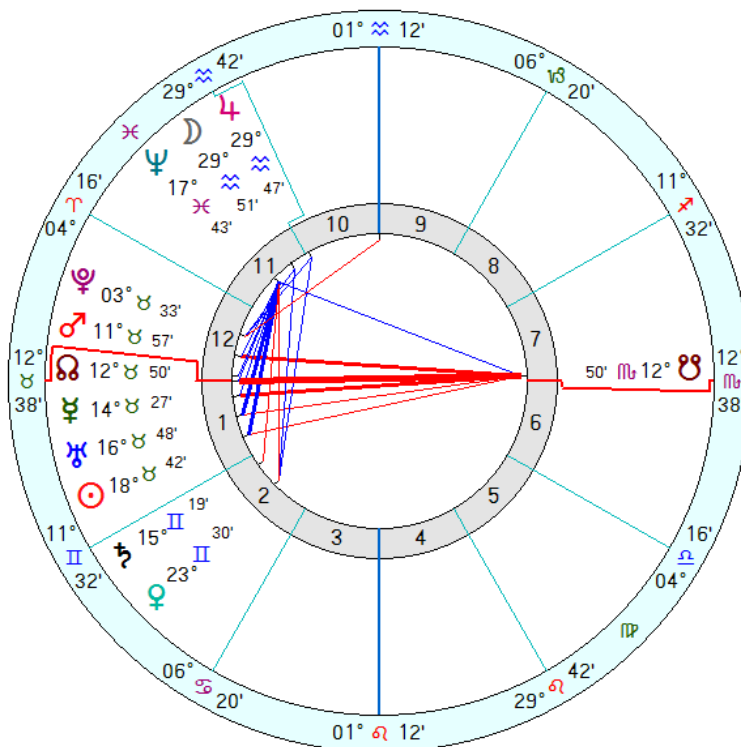

Ascendant

The Ascendant The Ascendant, or Rising Sign, is the degree of the zodiac that was appearing on the eastern horizon at the exact moment and place of your

birth. It is the doorway through which your soul entered this world, and it represents your outer personality, the mask you wear, and the way you present yourself to others and to life itself. It describes your physical appearance, your natural behaviour, your first reaction to circumstances, and the impression you make upon people. While the Sun reveals your core identity and true purpose, and the Moon reflects your inner emotional world, the Ascendant shows how you express that identity and those feelings, and how you interact with your environment. It is the lens through which you view life, the filter that shapes all your experiences, and the vital energy that colours every part of your chart. It also signifies your physical body, your vitality, and the general direction and style of your life path. On a spiritual level, the Ascendant represents the lesson you came to learn, the role you chose to play in this lifetime, and the instrument you have been given to fulfil your destiny..

Ascendant in Taurus

Taurus was rising at your birth; a fixed earthy sign. In disposition you are loving and affectionate, fond of pleasure, and an admirer of beauty in all things. The sign Taurus often gives a love of music or art, with good taste in color, in melody, in dress, in ornaments, and elegance generally. You are cool, self-contained, firm, and strong-willed; a lover of peace, quiet, and harmony. You are also practical and desirous of putting everything to the test of practice and experience, and you value persons, things, and ideas largely for the use to which they can be put. You have much perseverance and quiet firmness, are somewhat reserved and self-centered, and you can show great obstinacy upon occasion. You do not change very easily, and are a little lacking in adaptability. Your course of life tends to move from day to day and even from year to year in its accustomed channels with comparatively little alteration. You are not easily influenced by other people, but are a persistent and patient worker in your own way and according to your own ideas. You are slow to anger but are apt to harbor resentment. ****Soul Evolution & Karmic Meaning****

In the language of cosmic astrology, Taurus on the Ascendant marks a soul that has already passed through the stage of discovery and action (represented by Aries) and has now entered the stage of ****consolidation, building, and learning about value****.

In previous existences, your soul often wasted resources, was unstable, changed paths constantly, or did not appreciate what it had. You may have taken beauty, love, or material goods for granted, or you lacked the patience to finish what you started. Sun

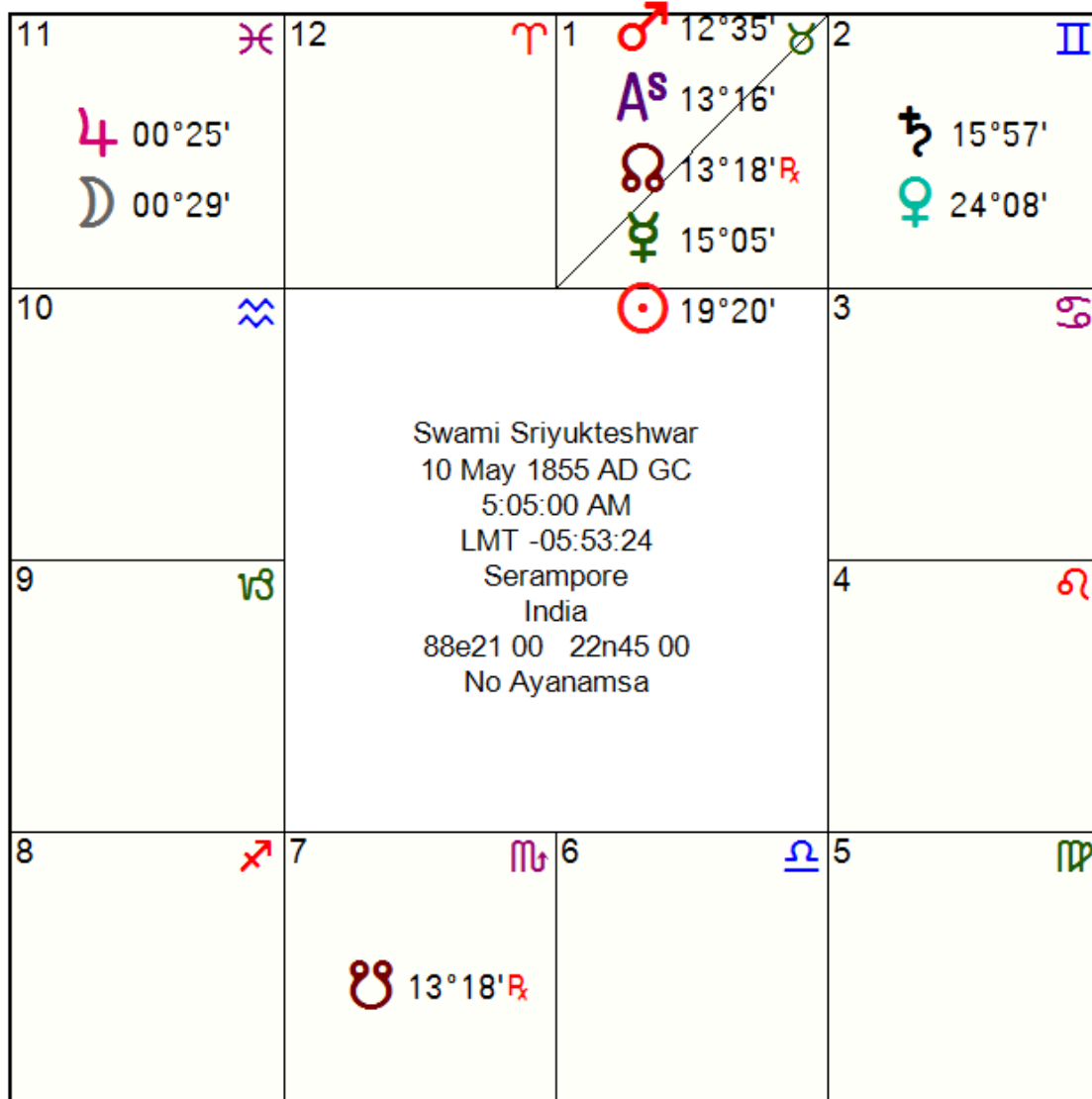

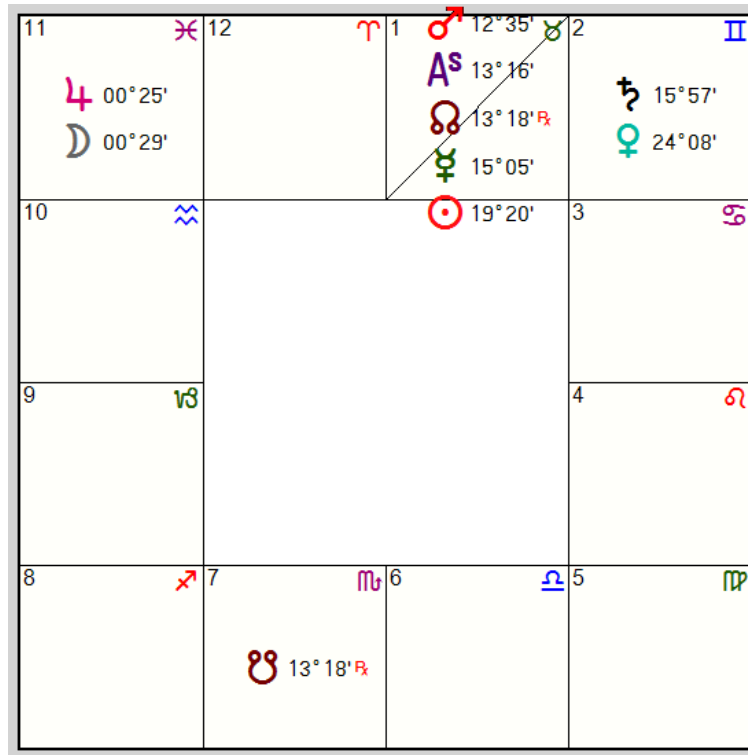

In Vedic astrology, charts are usually drawn using the Whole Sign house system. This means every house covers exactly one full sign. For example, if your Rising Sign is Aries, your First House begins at 0° Aries and spans the entire thirty degrees of that sign.

The building blocks are similar to Western astrology — planets, signs, houses, aspects — but there are three unique elements that form its very soul: Yogas (special combinations), Nakshatras (Lunar Mansions), and Dasas (time cycles).

Nakshatras are the 27 divisions of the sky based on the Moon's movement. While the Sun takes roughly 12 months to travel the zodiac, the Moon completes its circle in about 27

days. These 27 sections are smaller and more precise than the 12 signs, and they describe human nature, life events, and inner qualities with incredible accuracy and depth. They seem to touch the very core of who we are.

Dasas are the primary method used for prediction. They are periods of time when one specific planet in your birth chart becomes fully awake and active. During a Dasa, that planet's energy, its themes, and everything it represents in your life becomes central, shaping your experiences, lessons, and opportunities.

In this report, we explore the energies active at your birth to understand the forces that shaped you and your path in life. We also look at your current cycles to help you understand what is unfolding for you right now.

We trust you will find these insights meaningful, true, and deeply helpful.

How to use this Report

An astrologer sees every planet as having strengths and weaknesses, and every influence as a mix of light and shadow.

So, the themes described here are never only good or only bad — they are real, human, and complex.

When you read, remember that each description expresses a range of possibilities.

For example, if you read:

"If you were born into the Moon Dasa, your connection to your mother was very strong and fundamental to your well being."

Think about how that showed up in your life. It could mean deep love and safety, but it could also mean deep emotional intensity or dependency. It could mean she was nurturing, or she was moody. A strong bond is powerful in many ways.

Or if you read:

"You were an enthusiastic child, who wanted to be a hero; active, involved, alive, and strategic, a warrior, often pursuing and championing your goals."

Reflect on how your energy was received. Sometimes your courage was loved and encouraged; other times, it may have been seen as too much, too bold, or too wild.

Add your own life experience to these words, and you will find deep meaning and truth.

Dasas

In Vedic astrology, predictions rely mostly on the system called Dasas. Dasas are distinct time periods where one planet in your chart becomes dominant and alive. It is as if that planet steps forward to hold the light, and everything connected to it becomes a major theme in your life.

For example, if you are in the Moon Dasa, everything ruled by the Moon — your emotions, your home, your mother, your sense of safety, your inner world — becomes the focus. You will experience, learn, and grow through these areas. You will also feel the influence of the sign and house where the Moon sits in your birth chart.

The system used here is Vimshottari Dasa, the most widely respected and accurate method in Vedic astrology. The word Vimshottari means "120 years", which is the length of the full cycle. In this system, planets follow a fixed order and rule for fixed lengths of time.

What makes this system unique to you is which planet starts the cycle at your birth. This is determined by the ruler of the Nakshatra (Lunar Mansion) where the Moon was positioned at the moment you were born. This calculation is precise and personal.

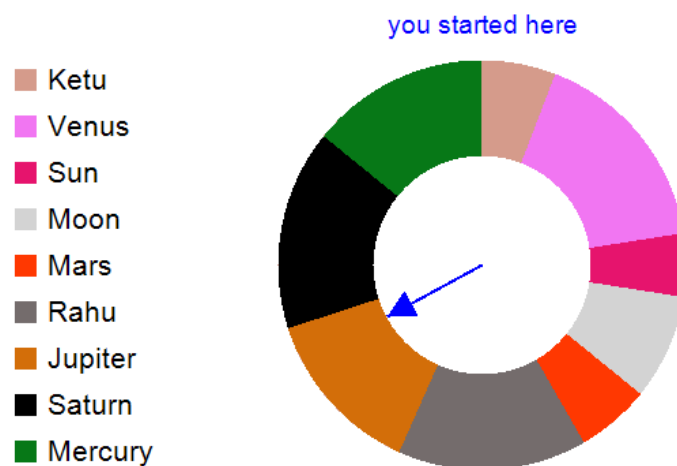
Since each Dasa lasts for many years, we divide it further into 9 smaller segments called Bhuktis. Each Bhukti is ruled by another planet, starting with the same planet ruling the main Dasa. So, if you are in Venus Dasa, the sequence begins Venus/Venus, then Venus/Sun, Venus/Moon, and so on. This notation simply means: Main Period / Sub Period.

Everyone enters life at a particular place in the ongoing Dasa sequence. Exploring the particularities of our starting point enable us to understand what shapes us from the beginning.

This report focuses on the Dasa you're born into, and what's activated in each person's chart. The Ascendant, and its Lord, are the clearest representatives of you yourself, followed by the Moon; and the First Dasa Lord indicates the themes and influences active at birth, so we examine the Nakshatra placements of all of these.

The First Dasa Lord Planet Jupiter

You were born into the Jupiter Dasa, and you brought a smile and an open heart into the world. You were naturally optimistic, kind, and generous — the kind of child everyone loves. If Jupiter was strong, you were respectful, grateful, and you trusted life easily. You accepted your circumstances and felt supported.

But if Jupiter was weak or afflicted, you may have experienced instability or uncertainty early on. Perhaps adults were unreliable, or promises were broken. This could have shaken your faith in people or in life itself. You needed to be treated with respect and to know that you were valued. When you received that, you grew up confident and big hearted.

Your Moon's Nakshatra at birth was Purva Bhadrapada

You are deeply sensitive to your surroundings and to people's moods. You feel every disharmony, every pain, and every confusion. You feel life's intensity strongly, and you have learned ways to protect yourself and to find peace. You use creativity, writing, or spiritual practice to calm your soul.

You want to build a good life, to contribute, and to make things better. You have moved through fire and storm, and you have come out wiser, calmer, and stronger. You are aligned with what is true and real.

Your Dasa Lord at birth was in its own sign

As a baby, you felt naturally secure and at peace. You felt "at home" in yourself, free to be exactly who you were. Your calm, loving, and true nature attracted people to you. You started life standing on solid ground, knowing deep inside that you are good, safe, and loved.
